Zephyrhills High School Prom Dress Code

- THS Staff and Administration will be enforcing the prom dress code for the event.
- Each student should make sure his or her attire meets dress code **BEFORE** the night of the prom. It is the responsibility of ZHS students to inform their dates of the guidelines.

Young Men:

Must wear a suit jacket, dress pants, dress shirt, tie, and dress shoes. All pants must be securely worn around the waist. Athletic shoes/sneakers (i.e. Nike, Adidas, etc.), skate shoes (i.e. Vans, Airwalk, etc.), or work boots are not and will not be permitted.

Young Women:

Must wear a dress or gown, pantsuit, or skirt and blouse that is in good taste. Only side cutouts are permitted but MUST be covered with mesh material. Strapless dresses or gowns are allowed. All dresses or gowns must cover the midriff areas completely and the back cannot be cut lower that the waistline. The dress length and all slits cannot exceed more than four inches above the knee.

Dress Code for Both Young Men and Women:

Students dressed inappropriately will be turned away at the door. Students will not be admitted wearing cargo pants, sneakers, jeans, t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts bandanas, hats, or any item referencing tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or gangs. Only students and guests adhering to the dress requirements will be admitted to the Prom. *Refunds will not be granted.*

Back must <u>NOT</u> fall below the waistline.

Midriff must **NOT** be exposed.



Necklines must <u>NOT</u> fall below the underarm and slit must not exceed 4 inches above the knee.



Dress hem must reach at least 4 inches to the knee.

No cover-ups will be allowed to bring dress or gown up to code. The dress or gown must meet dress code on its own.
