ESY/Distance Learning/APEX Guidelines

May 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Your child has been enrolled in the ZHS extended school year program (ESY) because s/he is either behind in credits or has a GPA below a 2.0. Our goal is for all students to enter the 2020-2021 on track and prepared for graduation. As a result, successfully attending ESY will help your child meet this goal. This letter provides all the information needed for your student to be successful in this program.

DL Summer School Dates: <u>20 Day Program</u>. The program will run <u>Monday - Thursday</u>. <u>No school on Fridays</u> Dates: <u>June</u> 8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 17, 18, 22, 23, 24, 25; <u>July</u> 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, 16
Students must sign into APEX from 9:15am -12:45pm (times subject to change), students must work at least 3 ½ hours a day <u>and</u> complete approximately 10% daily.

All parts of APEX must be completed. Paper portions (journals, practices, and TST's) are required. Student can complete the paper portion on a word document and can be emailed to the teacher, but all parts of the course are required. APEX has a graph that daily provides teachers and admin with the exact amount of time spent in APEX, and what was done during that time. Teachers provide admin with a daily report, and parents will be contacted if work requirements are not met or if the student is not making adequate progress.

Students have 20 days to complete 1 to 2 semester courses. This is done by completing work requirements every day. Students must attend online work sessions every day. There is no absenteeism. Please call ZHS at 813-794-6100 if an emergency arises.

Students will be dismissed from the ESY Summer Program for any of the following reasons:

- 1. Failure to show satisfactory progress (as determined by the instructor and/or ESY administrator).
- 2. Failure to maintain satisfactory and timely attendance.
- 3. Plagiarizing (cheating or copying) either from another student's work, online, or any other resource.
