 NOTE: It is recommended that students who plan to take Chemistry 1 Hon in 10<sup>th</sup> grade should complete both Biology 1 Hon and Geometry Hon in 9<sup>th</sup> grade.

**NOTE:** Due to the Florida state-mandated Class Size Amendment, core academic courses cannot have more than 25 students enrolled in each class on average. Therefore, a student may not receive all the honors courses he/she requested.

However, if none of the choices fit, we will place them in similar courses or wherever there is room so that the students are fully enrolled in 6 classes each semester.

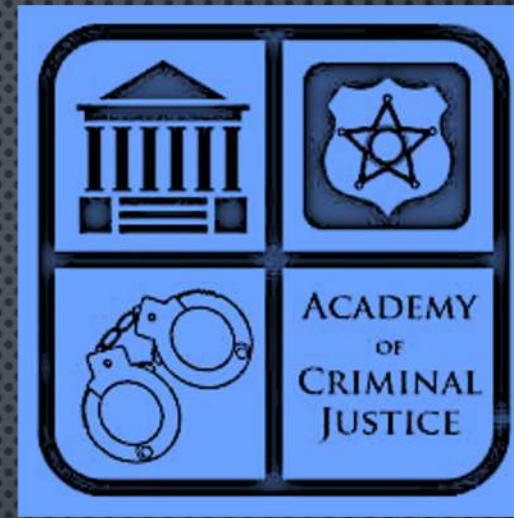

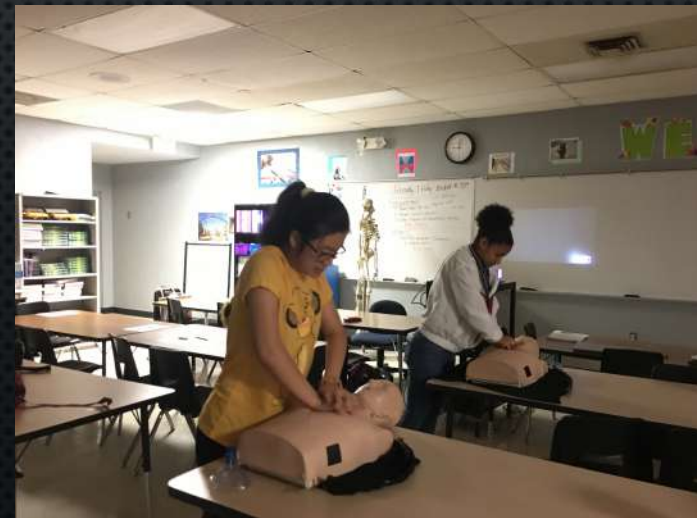

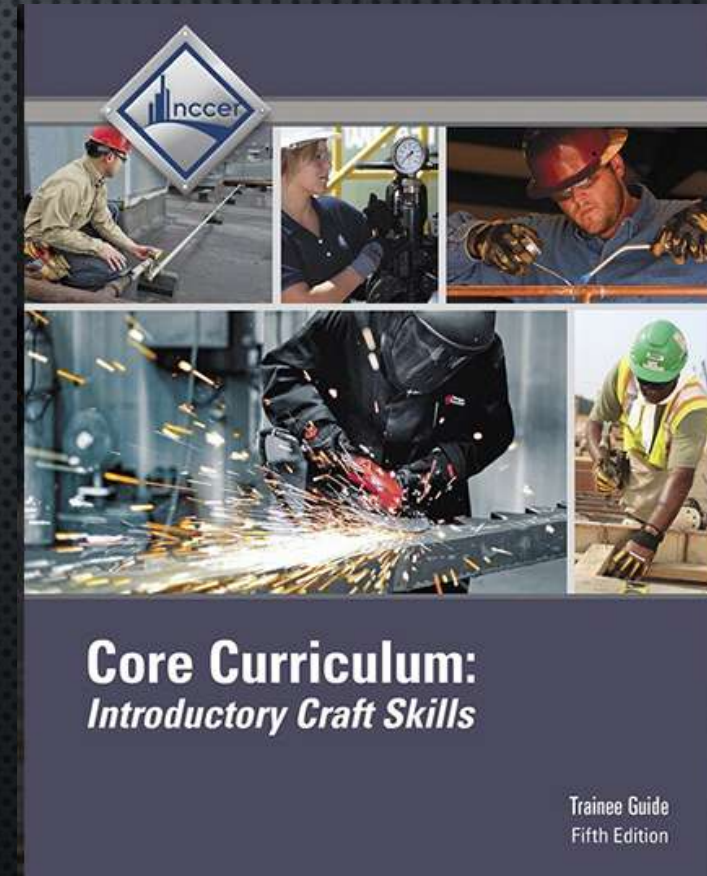

# 911 PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATOR

- “911 PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATOR” MEANS A PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHER OR 911 OPERATOR WHOSE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE THE ANSWERING, RECEIVING, TRANSFERRING, AND DISPATCHING FUNCTIONS RELATED TO 911 CALLS; DISPATCHING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, FIRE RESCUE SERVICES, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, AND OTHER PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES TO THE SCENE OF AN EMERGENCY

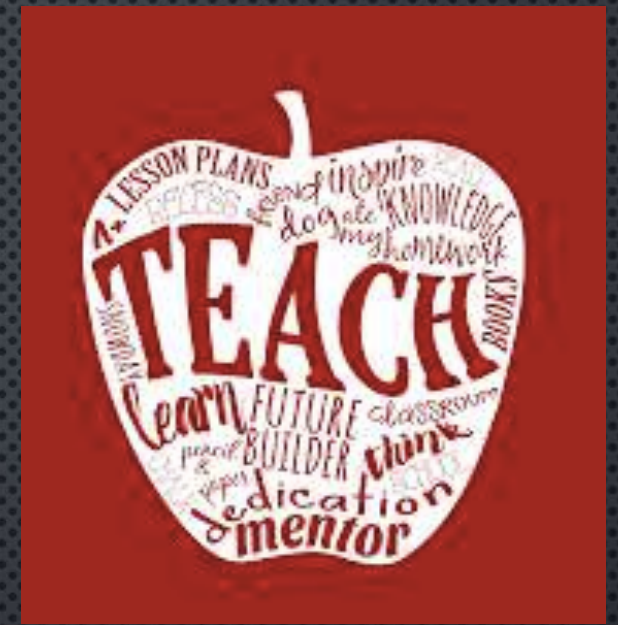
