Electronics Use Policy:

What is an electronic device:

- Cell Phones
- Tablets or iPads
- Smartwatches
- iPods, MP3 Players
- Headphones and earbuds
- Web-enabled devices of any type

All Electronic Devices are to remain <u>out of sight</u> during class time. If a student's electronic device is seen during class time, the device will be confiscated until the end of the day.

Electronics may only be used when a teacher directed and monitored activity is occurring in the class.

<u>Violations:</u>

 1^{st} offense- Student may pick the device up at the end of the day in student services

 2^{nd} offense- Student may pick the device up at the end of the day in student services and is assigned lunch detention

3rd offense- Parent must pick the device up at the end of the day in student services

- Electronic Devices must be picked up in student services by 2:05 pm
- If the student refuses to turn in the device the teacher will call student services to have the student removed and a referral for defiance of authority will be written with a day of ISS assigned.
- Teacher will call student services to have the phone picked up during passing time by a discipline IA.
