

Zephyrhills High School Homecoming - "No-Go" List Action Plan October 30, 2021

In order to attend Homecoming 2021, ZHS students must have:

- *80% attendance rate or higher for the school year.
- *no more than 3 level 2 referrals and 0 level 3 referrals.
- *a 2.0 or higher cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).

If you are currently on the "No-Go" list, you may not submit an appeal to be reconsidered until you have completed the following:

Attendance:

1. Absences may be cleared when you provide a note with specific dates from the medical provider you went to see during school hours (i.e. doctor, dentist, etc.). *Notes from parents will not be accepted to go back and clear previous absences. Only medical notes with specific dates are allowed.*
2. Meet with your grade level administrator or graduation coach to determine the days and times and with whom you will complete detention to make up for lost/missed school days. Create the chart of dates/times on the back of this form. Have your grade level administrator or graduation coach sign off on your chart before you start.
 - a. 5 lunch detentions will "clear" 1 school day (for HOCO purposes only).
 - b. 5 after school detentions will "clear" 3 school days (for HOCO purposes only).
 - c. 1 Saturday School will "clear" 3 school days (for HOCO purposes only).
3. Once your chart is complete, you can submit your appeal letter (along with your completed chart and signatures) to Dr. Stanley.

Referrals:

1. Meet with your grade level administrator or graduation coach to determine the days and times and with whom you will complete community service hours. Create the chart of dates/hours on the back of this form. Have your grade level administrator or graduation coach sign off on your chart before you start.
 - a. You can volunteer in the cafeteria, assist the custodians during lunch with campus clean up, or assist the custodians after school with campus clean up.
 - b. You are welcome to come up with your own ways of giving back/serving your community.
 - i. Level 2 referrals:
 1. 5 days of lunch clean-up will count toward one level 2 referral.
 2. 5 days of after school clean-up will count toward two level 2 referrals.
 - ii. Level 3 referrals:
 1. See Dr. Stanley.
2. Once your chart is complete, you can submit your appeal letter (along with your completed chart and signatures) to Dr. Stanley.

Grade Point Average:

1. Meet with your grade level administrator or graduation coach to determine the days and times and with whom you will complete tutoring/study time/make up work. Create the chart of dates/hours on the back of this form. Have your grade level administrator or graduation coach sign off on your chart before you start.
2. Once your chart is complete, you can submit your appeal letter (along with your completed chart and signatures) to Dr. Stanley.
