# Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery

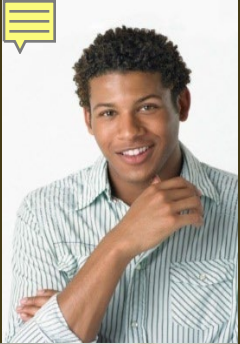


The ASVAB CEP is a complete career planning program. Students are given the opportunity to take the ASVAB at no cost and no commitment to military service. The ASVAB CEP also provides an interest assessment and planning tools to help young adults explore career field entry requirements and various career paths, both military and civilian.

# University Admissions

- ▣ Need 18 academic credits  
(Eng. Math, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Lang. 2 academic credits)
- ▣ Need 2 years of the SAME Foreign Language
- ▣ Need to take SAT and/or ACT
- ▣ Test scores and GPA must be competitive





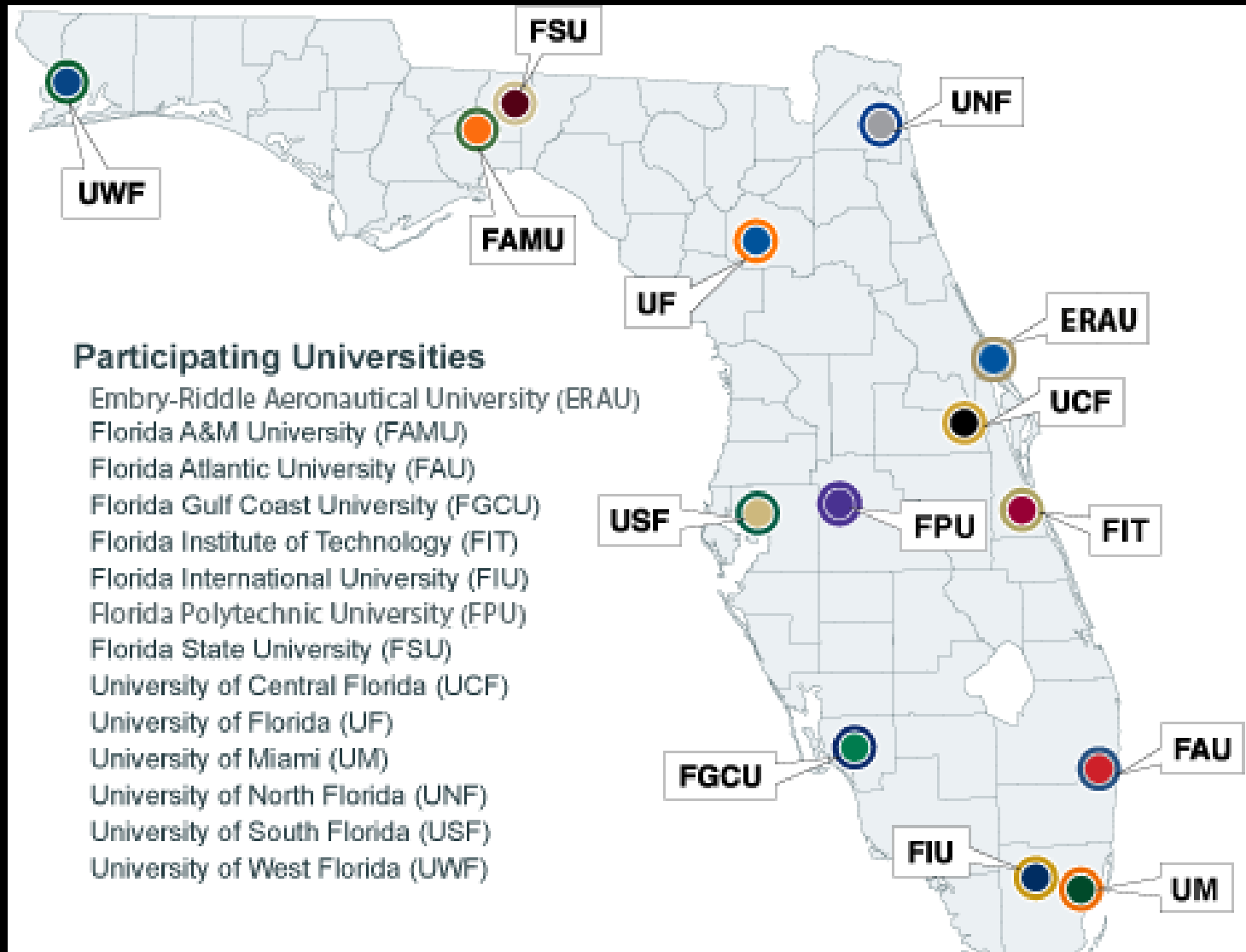
# College Costs-Per Year



- Public 2-year college (tuition and fees, in-state) - **\$3,440** (PHSC, HCC, Polk State College)
- Public 4-year college (tuition and fees, in-state) - **\$9,410** (USF, UCF, UF, FSU)
- Public 4-year college (tuition and fees, out of state) - **\$24,890** (Valdosta State)
- Private 4-year college (tuition and fees) - **\$32,410-\$42,000** (St. Leo, Florida Southern)

- ▣ 1330 SAT or 29 ACT Composite
- ▣ 3.5 weighted GPA in core academic courses
- ▣ 100 Community Service Hours
- ▣ OR 100 Documented Work Hours
- ▣ 2 Years of Foreign Language

# Florida Medallion Scholars

## (75% Tuition & Fees)

### Requirements

- ▣ 1210 SAT or 25 ACT Composite
- ▣ 3.0 weighted GPA in core academic courses
- ▣ 75 Community Service Hours
- ▣ OR 100 Documented Work Hours
- ▣ 2 Years of Foreign Language

# Gold Seal Vocational Scholars

(Pays a flat rate)

- ▣ SAT: Reading 440 Math 440
- ▣ ACT: English 17 Reading 19 Math 19
- ▣ PERT: Reading 106 Writing 103 Math 114
- ▣ Need 3.0 in core academic courses
- ▣ Need 3.5 in 3 sequential and approved vocational courses
- ▣ 30 Community Service hours

# Senior Year College Timeline

*Your senior year is when your hard work and planning pay off. Complete college applications in the fall and be aware of deadlines.*

- ▣ **Aug/Sept-** Meet with your counselor/career specialist to discuss your college plans. Go over your ACT and/or SAT scores and determine if you need to retake either of these tests.

# *Timeline Continued*

- ▣ **October-** Complete college admissions and financial aid applications. Be sure to apply to at least one “safety school.”
- ▣ College Application deadline Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>!
- ▣ Retake the ACT and/or SAT if necessary.
- ▣ Complete FAFSA Application online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov), opens Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>.

# *Timeline Continued*

- ▣ **November-** Continue to work on Community Service Hours!
- ▣ **December** – Retake the ACT and/or SAT if necessary.
- ▣ **Jan-March-** Seek out and complete local scholarship opportunities. See ZHS College & Career Resource website.
- ▣ **April** – Decide which college to attend, return award letters, and if you plan to live on campus, send in your housing deposit.
