## ESY Guidelines - Summer, 2023

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Your child has been enrolled in the ZHS Summer ESY program because he or she is either behind in credits or has a GPA below 2.0. ESY will be held at Zephyrhills High School (ZHS), and our goal is for all students to enter the 2023-2024 school year, on track and prepared for graduation. As a result, successfully attending ESY will help your child to meet this goal. This letter provides all the information needed for your student to be successful in this program.

ESY Summer School Dates: <u>20-Day Program</u>. The program will run <u>Monday – Thursday</u> most weeks. <u>However</u>, please note there will be no school on Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, or Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. Instead, there will be school on Friday, July 7<sup>th</sup>.

- o June 19, 20, 21, 22
- o June 26, 27, 28, 29
- o July 5, 6, 7
- o July 10

Students must be in class and signed on to APEX from 9:45am -1:15pm, they must work at least 3 ½ hours a day, <u>and</u> complete approximately 10% daily. Transportation will be provided for those students who qualify.

All parts of APEX must be completed. Paper portions (journals, practices, and TST's) are required. APEX has a graph that provides teachers and admin daily with the exact amount of time spent in APEX, and what was done during that time. Teachers provide admin with a daily report, and parents will be contacted if work requirements are not met or if the student is not making adequate progress.

Students have 20 days to complete 1 - 2 semester courses. This is done by completing work requirements every day. Students must attend ESY every day. There is no absenteeism. Please call if an emergency arises.

Students will be dismissed from the ESY Summer Program for any of the following reasons:

- 1. Failure to show satisfactory progress (as determined by the instructor and/or ESY administrator).
- 2. Failure to maintain satisfactory and timely attendance.
- 3. Plagiarizing (cheating or copying) either from another student's work, online, or any other resource.

Extended school year offers a time for reflection, growth, and preparation for the upcoming year. We look forward to sharing these experiences with your child. If you have questions, please feel free to call ZHS at 813-794-6100.
