

**Zephyrhills High School**  
**Grad Bash on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

To ensure that all have a memorable evening, all participants must abide by the Pasco County Schools Student Code of Conduct, in particular the following:

1. You must be in attendance for all scheduled/assigned classes on Friday for the Saturday event. Students that **do not** attend school Friday, April 4th will not be permitted to attend Grad Bash, and there will be **NO REFUND**.
2. All students must arrive at the school no later than 12:00 PM. Busses will leave promptly at 12:30 pm. Do not be late as the buses will depart on time whether all students have shown up or not.
3. You observe the Pasco County Schools Dress Code, Universal Studio's dress code (Universal Studio's policies on reverse side) and Student Code of Conduct at all times.
4. There are **NO REFUNDS** for any reason and tickets are NOT eligible for re-sale. **After you purchase your ticket(s), attendance, GPA, and behavior standards MUST be maintained. If requirements are not maintained, attendance will be revoked without a refund.**
5. You are not permitted to:
  - ▶ Use, be in possession, or be under the influence of any type of drugs, vapes, or alcoholic beverages.
  - ▶ Be in possession of any type of weapon, including any look-alike weapon.
  - ▶ Use any tobacco product or vapes, in compliance with State Law and District Policy
  - ▶ Bring any unsealed/unopened beverages on the bus. **No re-usable cups are permitted.**
6. **All individuals attending the event will be subject to search and pat down by the event/security staff before boarding the bus.**
7. Any violation of school rules or inappropriate behavior may result in your immediate removal from the event and may result in disciplinary action, in accordance with school policy and the Pasco County Schools Code of Conduct.
8. Once the bus leaves for Grad Bash, students are not permitted to leave the event early. All students will return on the bus.
9. It is your responsibility to arrange for a ride home from the event. All rides must be in the designated area promptly at 4am.

**Transportation Release (MIS Form #166)**

In consideration of your student having been accepted by the principal, teacher(s), or other personnel of Zephyrhills High School of the District School Board of Pasco County to go on a school sponsored trip to Universal Orlando Resort, and I, the undersigned, understand that my child, if transported by a charter bus, school bus/van or walking, hereby release the District School Board of Pasco County, the individual members of said Board, the Superintendent, the principal, teachers or other employees of the school, and volunteer leaders from any financial responsibility because of sickness of the student while going to, returning from, or attending said field trip or because of any accident in which the student is injured. To ensure prompt attention in case of sickness or accident, I hereby authorize the person(s) in charge of said trip to incur expenses considered necessary for treatment, and I agree to pay for same if this is in excess of the amount paid by any accident or health insurance policy that may be in effect at the time of the sickness or accident.

- In any situation in which the safety and security of students might be compromised (e.g., Red Alert Status issued by the Department of Homeland Security, severe weather conditions, etc.) the District School Board of Pasco County will take the necessary steps to ensure the safety of its students and staff, including the cancellation of scheduled field trips and school events.
- I have documented below all precautions/instructions regarding my child's medication. I have noted any special health related conditions or allergies regarding my child. I understand that the trained school employee who usually dispenses medication may or may not be present during the trip. Medications will be dispensed by a trained school employee (in accordance with Board Policy 5330). **\*Universal Orlando will enforce these rules and policies. Any student in violation on the day of the event will not be permitted on the bus and will not receive a ticket or refund.**

We want all participants to be comfortable during Grad Bash. This document will provide details on what is acceptable and not acceptable to wear to Grad Bash. Universal Orlando Resort's Security team strictly enforces all dress code regulations for

## School Name/Logo Attire

- Seniors are **NOT** permitted to wear attire with their school's name or logo
- Chaperones **ARE** allowed to wear school name and logo attire

## College/Professional Attire

- College and Professional team names and logos on clothing attire are permitted (i.e. polos, shirts)
- No** jerseys of any kind are permitted

## What is OK to wear to Grad Bash

### Accessories

- Sunglasses, hats, & belts Bags/Purses
- Any bags and purses must be under the size of 8.5" x 5.5" (half a sheet of paper)
- Drawstrings bags ARE allowed

### Tops/Shirts

- Casual tops and T-shirts
- No midriff shirts, shirt sleeves must be 3" wide, no halter tops
- Brand name (i.e. Nike, Adidas, Under Armor, etc.) are allowed
- No undershirts as an outer garment
- Jackets are allowed (**no school jackets**)  
\*Please check all undergarments underneath jackets prior to departing high school campus

### Bottoms

- Jeans, leggings, running shorts, shorts, and skirts are permitted
- Excessive holes/ shreds on jeans are not allowed. Leggings cannot be sheer or of see-through material

### Dresses

- Dresses and rompers are permitted; must be mid-thigh in length, sleeves must be 3" wide
- Spandex bodysuits will not be permitted Shoes
- Comfortable shoes, tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots, and flip flops are permitted
